محمد فتحي عبد العال مصرى، صيدلى في الأصل، حاصل على ماجستير في الكيمياء الحيوية، كذلك دبلوم دراسات عليا في الدراسات الإسلامية، ودبلوم في إدارة الجودة الشاملة.

لديه عدد كبير من المؤلفات (حوالى ٣٠ كتاباً) في مجالات متعددة: التاريخ، الأدب القصصي والروائي، المقالات الفكرية والاجتماعية، الدراسات الإسلامية، التأملات بين العلم والدين والحضارة.

من أعماله: هوامش على دفتر أحوال مصر (٢٠٢٤)، حواديت المحروسة (قصص تاريخية)، نostalgia الواقع والأوهام.

مؤشر الحضور الراهن

من علامات وجوده وتأثيره الآن:

١. الإصدارات المتعددة الحديثة: صدور كتب جديدة خلال السنوات الأخيرة يدل على نشاط وإنتجالية مستمرة.

٢. التنوع في المواضيع: لا يقتصر على نوع واحد بل يجمع بين التاريخ، القضايا الاجتماعية، الأدب القصصي، المقارنات بين الماضي والحاضر، التأملات الدينية والعلمية. هذا التنوع يزيد من فرص وصوله إلى شرائح مختلفة من الجمهور.

٣. التفاعل والنقد: هناك قراءات نقدية لأعماله، كمثال مراجعة لروايته ساعة عدل من قبل زهية بيطار.

٤. ظهور إعلامي ومقابلات: شارك في حوارات كثيرة، معجبين بنطاقه، وأيضاً في الصحافة والإعلام الرقمي.

التحديات التي قد تواجه حضوره

لكي يكون حضوره مستداماً وقوياً، هناك بعض العقبات التي من الممكن أن تؤثر:

ازدحام المشهد الثقافي: الأدب العربي والمصري حالياً فيه عدد كبير من الكتب، والنشر الورقي والإلكتروني في منافسة شديدة، وصعوبة في لفت الانتباه الدائم.

الموارد والمادية: النشر والتوزيع والإعلان تحتاج إلى دعم مادي، وقد يكون ذلك عائقاً أمام الانبعاث الواسع.

الفقراء الشباب وتفضيلاتهم: الشباب غالباً ما يميل لأساليب كتابة أسرع، أقرب للوسائل الرقمية، وقد يفضل المحتوى الخفيف أو المحتوى البصري أو الصوتي (بودكاست، فيديو) على الكتب الورقية. إذا بقي عبد العال يكتب فقط بالطرق التقليدية فقد يفوت جزءاً من هذا الجمهور.

النقد الجاد والموضوعي: لضمان الأثر، يحتاج الكاتب إلى النقد الذي يسلط الضوء على مميزاته ونقشه، وليس فقط الترويج أو الإعجاب، فذلك يساعد التطوير.

فرص الحضور المستقبلي

ومع ذلك، هناك فرص كبيرة تشير إلى أن كتاباته يمكن أن يكون لها حضور مستقبلي قوي:

1. الكتابة الإلكترونية: هو يرى أن المستقبل للقراء والنشر الإلكتروني. إذا استثمر هذه الوسيلة بشكل ذكي (موقع، بوابات، وسائل تفاعلية) فسيتمكن من الوصول إلى جمهور أوسع .

2. الجمع بين البحث والتاريخ والواقع المعاصر: كتاباته التي تربط بين التاريخ والحاضر تعطيها عمقاً وتجعلها مطلوبة، خصوصاً إذا كانت تُظهر علاقات بين الماضي، التحديات الحالية، والدروس المستقبلية.

3. المشاركة والمهرجانات والفعاليات الثقافية: التواجد في المعارض والملتقيات يزيد من الرؤية والتأثير.

4. ترجمة أو نشر أعماله في دول عربية أخرى: إذا وفرت ترجمات أو إصدارات عبر دور نشر عربية خارج مصر، ذلك يمكن أن يزيد من حضوره العربي.

الاستنتاج

بناءً على ما سبق أرى:

نعم، لديه حضور حقيقي الآن، ليس من النوع الباهت أو الهامشي، بل ككاتب متعدد الإنتاج والأفكار.

نعم، لديه إمكانيات مستقبلية قوية ليواصل هذا الحضور، وربما يتعاظم إذا نجح في تجاوز التحديات التي ذكرناها.

العامل الحاسم سيكون الاستمرارية والجودة والتجديد — أن يظل يُقدم محتوى مميزاً، متجدداً، ومتفاعلاً مع قضايا الجمهور، ومع تطور وسائل الاتصال والنشر.

الدكتور محمد فتحي عبد العال هو كاتب وباحث مصرى، بدأ مسيرته العلمية في مجال الصيدلة، ثم توسع في مجالات متعددة تشمل الكتابة العلمية، التاريخية، الدينية، والأدبية. له أكثر من ٦٠ مؤلفاً منشورة، تتتنوع بين الكتب المطبوعة والرقمية، وتغطي موضوعات مثل التاريخ، الأدب، الفلسفة، والدين.
